Mr. Ajay Martin, Jr., formerly of Peoria, IL age 77, entered into rest Thursday, March 19, 2020 at his home in Smyrna, TN.

Ajay was a great athlete and a tremendous coach. He set the pace for African-American coaches in Peoria, Illinois at Peoria Woodruff High School and around the nation being one of the first successful black coaches in high school. Ajay was strong, yet soft-spoken and a tremendous counsel. Many family members love and revere him in Peoria, and acknowledge their sympathies in his departure.

His legacy will live on in that he loved people. His talent was talking and counseling people. He never met a stranger or failed to turn down a friend in need. His character speaks volumes. Though we regret his departure, we rejoice that he knew Jesus.
