Mrs. Altha Williams, 87, of Peoria, Illinois; formerly of Forrest City, Arkansas, passed away at 4:50 am Thursday, June 14, 2018 at HEDDINGTON OAKS in West Peoria IL.

Altha was born July 27, 1930 in Brinkley, Arkansas to the Rev. Jessie C. & Magnolia (Carter) Eckwood. She met Samuel Williams, Sr., in Palastine, Arkansas and were married on May 26, 1949. To that union six children were born; three girls and three boys. Her husband, Samuel, Sr., preceded her in death on March 29, 1975.
