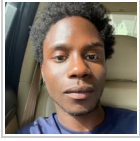
Angela loved making scented candles, going to the movies and hanging out with her family.

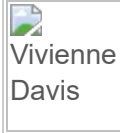

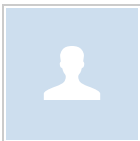

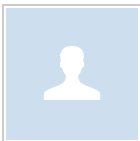
