



Mrs. Avis V. Johnson-Duncan

Mrs. Avis V. Johnson-Duncan of Colorado Springs, CO transitioned to be with our Heavenly Father at 5:07 a.m. MST on Monday, November 7, 2022 surrounded by family at Penrose Hospital, Colorado Springs, CO.

Avis was born to proud parents Gairline & Sterling Johnson on September 14, 1961 in Peoria, IL. Being the baby girl of five children, she was the “apple of their eye” holding a special place in their hearts. Avis confessed that she loved the Lord and was baptized at Mt. Zion Baptist Church at an early age in Peoria and attended services there. Inheriting the voice of a songbird from her father, she was a member of their gospel choir until her move to Colorado Springs.

Avis met and married Howard A. "Sonny" Duncan, Jr. and they celebrated 31 years of marriage. After their marriage they moved to Colorado to work with the USA Junior Olympic Boxing team. They enjoyed extensive travel with the boxers to places like Cuba, Greece, Michigan, Russia, the Bahamas, Atlanta, Puerto Rico, Australia, London and Rio de Janeiro. He preceded her in death on December 26, 2019.

Avis was a proud 1979 graduate of Peoria Manual High School participating as a cheerleader, a 1982 graduate of Midstate College and she received her Bachelor of Science in Business Administration from Regis University in 1999.

Avis had gainful employment at Farmers Insurance and began her time in management with Time Warner (now known as Spectrum) in 2002 from which she retired in July of 2022 after becoming ill.

Having a beautiful voice as a young woman, she was often encouraged to try out for reality shows such as Star Search and American Idol. She also participated in several beauty contests as a youth, winning the local Elks beauty queen contest. Avis had a gardener's thumb with the ability to grow flourishing green plants. She also enjoyed knitting, sewing, and crafts. Avis was an avid bingo player, often traveling to remote Indian reservations or Las Vegas to engage in a tournament. She loved to roller skate as a youth and continued to do so as an adult. She liked to read, cook, and enjoyed home improvement...always with a tape measure in hand. But, most of all she enjoyed spending time with her grandchildren.

To celebrate her life and cherish her memories are her loving and devoted son Andrew (Jennifer) Johnson of Colorado Springs, CO; stepdaughters Kathie Reed of Waterloo, IA, Tara Duncan of Galesburg, IL, and Davonne Duncan of Orange, NJ; her mother Girline Johnson of Peoria, IL; sisters Regina (Keith) Hayes of Los Angeles, CA and Lynnette Lee of Peoria, IL; and one brother Lester (Cassandra) Johnson of Austin, TX. She is also survived by her grandchildren who held a very special place in her heart: Kilara Olson, Andrew Johnson II, Josiah Johnson, Arayah Johnson, and Micah Johnson all of Colorado Springs, CO; her lifelong friend Tonya Strong of Peoria, IL; and a host of aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends who loved her dearly. She is preceded in death by her husband Howard Duncan; stepson Howard "Skip" Duncan III; father Sterling Johnson; mother-in-law Louise Duncan; brother Henry Humbles; nephew Vilancio Johnson, and brothers-in-law Carlos Duncan and Ronnie Lee.

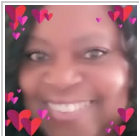
