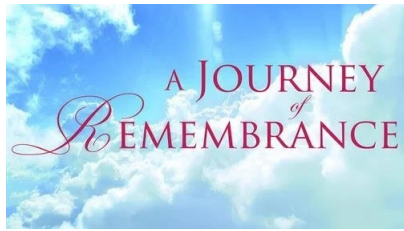
"BJ" will be deeply missed by her family and friends. We will all cherish loving memories of her.
