



## Mr. Charlie Lee Hill

September 3, 1949 - January 29, 2022

Elder Charlie Lee Hill, 72, of Peoria, IL passed away at 10:40 am on Saturday, January 29, 2022 at UnityPoint Health Methodist Hospital.
