Mr. Christopher Shaun Ferguson, 26, of 2221 W. Willow Knolls, Peoria, Ill., passed away Friday, July 28, 2006, at 1:20 a.m.

Chris was born Aug. 29, 1979, in Peoria to Brenda Payton and John Ferguson III.

He graduated from Dunlap High School in 1999, where he was a member of the basketball team.

Chris was Brenda's only child. He leaves to cherish his precious memory his loving and devoted parents, his mother, Brenda, his father and stepmother, John III and Betty Ferguson, all of Peoria; one loving daughter, Jada C.

Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Saturday, Aug. 5, 2006, at St. Paul Baptist Church.

A visitation will be held from 5 to 7 p.m. Friday, Aug. 4, 2006, at Simons Mortuary Chapel and one hour prior to the church service Saturday beginning at 9 a.m.

Chris will be laid to rest at Swan Lake Memory Gardens.

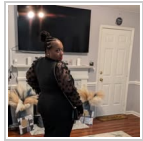

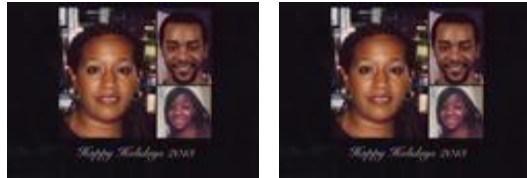
