Ms. Deborah Jean Rias, 70, of Peoria, IL, passed away on Tuesday, February 18, 2025 at her residence.

Deborah was born in Peoria, IL on May 16, 1954 to Joella Henning and Lincoln Mabins, Jr.

Deborah was a 1972 Manual High School graduate where she excelled academically. She earned a Bachelor of Arts degree Cum Laude from Eureka College in the Social Science Divisions in July 1975. She also earned a Master of Arts degree in Social Justice Professions with a specialized concentration in Human Services from the University of Illinois (Sangamon State University) in May of 1983. Deborah was also certified by the State Teacher Certification Board for the State of Illinois as a substitute teacher.

Deborah worked as a drug rehabilitation counselor at the Human Service Center/Fayette Companies, a substitute teacher for Peoria Public School District 150, a counselor at Martin Luther Homes of Illinois and retired as a case manager from the Illinois Department of Human Services.

Deborah loved swimming, listening to music, traveling, fishing, writing and reciting poetry. She was an excellent cook and also loved to bake. Her love of cooking was demonstrated by the love and care she put into cooking the food

for her family and friends. Deborah was baptized at Mt. Zion M. B. Church under the leadership of Rev. Wendell Phillips and Rev. Alphonso Lyons, Jr. She worked diligently on the culinary committee, she was a loyal choir member, and she helped out in the food pantry Deborah was also a member of the Women's Auxiliary and was a former Missionary Society Queen. She spent many years volunteering with the NAACP fighting for social justice.
