Mother Delores Hazel Williams, 88, of Peoria, IL transitioned to her heavenly home at 8:56 am on Wednesday, May 13, 2020 at her residence surrounded by her family.

Delores was born on May 9, 1932 in Kanawha, TX, one of 18 children born to Nelson "Bud" and Lillie (Johnson) Hearn. She moved to Peoria to live with her cousin Ida Bell and it is there where she met and married the love of her life, Naymond Williams. They married June 13, 1952 and shared over 54 years of marriage until his passing on February 8, 2007.
