Mrs. Doris Mae Taylor, 90, of Peoria, IL passed away peacefully at her home surrounded by her loving and devoted family at 8:33 pm on Saturday, February 20, 2016.

Mother Taylor was born on March 28, 1925 in Grand Chain, IL to Fred and Luella (Brooks) Anderson. She married Alonzo Taylor on October 23, 1946 in Peoria; he preceded her in death in 1998.

Mother Taylor loved her momma and daddy...next to them she was a devoted wife and mother. Family was very important to her. She was instrumental in organizing family gatherings. She was dedicated to the education of her children by taking leadership roles at their school as PTA president.

Mother Taylor was a Dietary worker at the Peoria State Hospital in Bartonville and Lunch Room Manager at Irving Grade school for many years retiring in 1974. She was an artful baker. She started her very own Cake decorating business which was very successful.

Mother Taylor was a faithful member of Holy Temple C.O.G.I.C., where she was an anointed Deaconess, prayer warrior, missionary evangelist, served on the prison ministry and YPWW. She was a past senior choir director, known for her awesome singing. She did a lot of traveling, especially with her sisters and close friends. Mother Taylor was very talented, her hobbies included crochet, macramé, painting, gardening and canning.
