Duane Alan "Heavy D" Stone, age 54, of Peoria Illinois, passed away Thursday at 10:36 PM on September 1st 2016 at his home.

Duane was born September 17th 1961 in Peoria Illinois to Kenard L. Stone Jr., and Rosalie M. (Rudd) Stone.

He accepted Christ at an early age at Mt. Zion Baptist Church. He played the viola in Grade School and graduated from Peoria High School in 1979.

He attained the rank of Sergeant in the Army where he is part of the 82nd Airborne Division in Fort Bragg North Carolina. While there he also directed the Ft. Bragg Military Choir. During that time he attained many awards and accommodations, SGT. Stone, Duane A.

He was a strong encourager to many and was a foster-parent with the Children's Home Association and was awarded many Certificates.

He was the CEO and Co-Founder of the ILL-State Riders Motor Cycle Club.

He loved singing, composing and was called upon to sing at numerous weddings and programs.

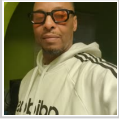

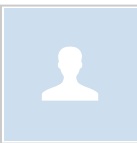

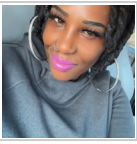
