PEORIA – Mr. Frank Scott Campbell, 97 of Peoria IL passed this life unto another peacefully at 10:27 am on December 22, 2012 at his residence. Frank was the Associate Director at the Carver Center for over 28 years and retired from the Insurance Claims Department at Caterpillar, Inc. in 1980. After retirement he remained an active member of the Caterpillar Retirees Club where he served on the Board of Directors.

Frank was a member of the Illinois and National Recreation Association, NAACP and in 1998 was inducted in the African American Hall of Fame Museum in Peoria, IL.
