Geary Steffan McNair, 63, of Peoria, IL passed away at 6:03 pm on Tuesday, October 18, 2016 at Unity Point Methodist Hospital.

Geary was born on February 6, 1953 in Seattle, WA to Avin Johnny and Garlene Theresa (Holt) McNair. Geary was a Veteran who honorably served over 12 years in the US Army. He later received an Associate's Degree from Illinois Central College. He was a past Code Enforcement Officer for many years with the City of Peoria. He was also a newspaper courier for the Peoria Journal Star for over 20 years. Geary was a faithful member of Heaven's View Christian Church where he served as a Trustee and Deacon. He presided over the usher board and was a member of the male chorus. Geary was an athlete. While in the military he was a featherweight boxer. He ran marathons in Chicago and Peoria. Geary raised his daughter Cotisha as a single parent. He married Rhonda Dunigan on June 2, 2012.

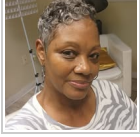
