Mother Hattie Will Lobdell, 97, of Houston, TX; formerly of Peoria, IL passed away peacefully at 11:26 am on Wednesday, June 29, 2022 at Harbor Hospice House of Houston, Houston, TX.

Hattie was born on February 18, 1925 in Columbus, MS to William and Cornelia (Brown) Seals. She married the love of her life, John Lobdell; he preceded her in death.

Hattie worked at Caterpillar, Inc., in housekeeping for over 20 years. 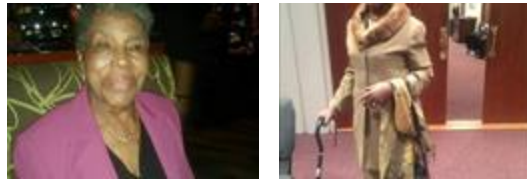
