Mrs. Helen Lorraine Jackson, 86, of Peoria, IL transitioned to her heavenly home at 8:45 am on Monday, August 24, 2020 at her home.

Helen was born on January 26, 1934 in Auxvasse, MO to Lonnie and Helen (Weaver) Brown. She married Earl Palmer Jackson on October 9, 1952 and they share 42 years of marriage. He preceded her in death in April of 1994. Helen had a strong work ethic. She worked as an Administrative Assistant for Metropolitan Life Insurance for many years. She also was a cashier at Venture Stores, and later worked as a Central Supply Supervisor for OSF St. Francis Hospital. From November 2006 to October 2013, Helen worked at Unity Point Methodist Daycare and volunteered as a PCCEO foster grandparent, where she served over 8500 volunteer hours.

Helen was a kind person and she loved her family and friends. Helen was also an avid bowler and was distinguished by being the first African American woman in the Peoria area to bowl a 600 series. Helen was a faithful member of Zion Baptist Church for over 50 years where she was a dedicated choir member.

Helen leaves to cherish her most precious memories her family which includes four daughters, Sonya Jackson of Peoria, IL, Marjorie Jackson of Woodbridge, VA, Kimberly (James "Bo") Hayes of Peoria, IL and Kristi (Larry) Spruill of Fayetteville, NC; one sister, Margaret Rudd of Chicago, IL; 16 grandchildren and 26 great-grandchildren ; and a host of nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends. She is also preceded in death by her parents; one

son, Rodney Duane Jackson; three brothers, Delroy Brown, Warren Brown and Lawrence "L.C." Brown; two sisters, Shirley White and Eliza "Odell" Burns and a sister-in-law, Martha Brown.

A Private funeral services will be held at 11 am on Saturday, September 5, 2020 at Zion Baptist Church. A visitation will be held one-hour prior beginning at 10 am. Pastor Sammuel Duren will bring words of comfort to the family. Helen will be laid to rest at Lutheran Cemetery.

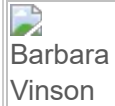
