May 15, 1934 - January 31, 2016

J.P. "Buck" Gordon, 81, of Peoria, IL peacefully passed away at 2:45 PM on January 31, 2016 at his residence. He was surrounded by his loving family. J.P. affectionately known as Buck, was born on May 15, 1934, in Cruger, Mississippi to the proud parents of Willie Gordon and Ellen (Randle) Gordon. He married the love his life, Freida Barbara Ferguson on January 9, 1954. They shared 62 years of holy matrimony.

J.P. leaves to cherish his most precious memories his loving wife and devoted family: Freida Barbara Gordon of Peoria, IL; one son, James Patrick Gordon of Peoria, IL; four daughters, Deborah Gordon, Imogene (Jeanie) Simmons, Pamela Gordon and Gwendolyn (Rene) Johnson all of Peoria, IL; one sister, Willie Mae (Artis) Gordon Hopson; six Grandchildren, Robert Davis, Carthel Johnson, Dionne Gordon, Jamie Johnson, Jimmel Simmons and Danielle Gordon. Preceding him in death was his parents; Willie and Ellen Gordon.

J.P. received his education at Meeks Elementary School in Cruger, MS and Roosevelt Jr., high School in Peoria, IL. As a child, Buck was baptized at Gordon Chapel Baptist Church in Cruger, MS. In 1950, he relocated to Peoria; IL later joined Morning Star Missionary Church. J.P. was a "golden member, serving over 50 years at the "Star."

Buck worked as a machinist at Keystone Wire and Steel for over 27 years, retiring in 1995.

Buck loved his family, fishing, gardening, hunting and bowling. He was an avid traveler who traveled with his wife throughout the continental United States by car only.

You could count on him to pull up in his pickup truck to visit the sick, his sister and Art or meet his favorite boys at the local McDonald's. Buck organized the first Gordon/Randle Reunion. In 2010, during our annual family reunion, Buck received special honor and was given an award for his leadership. To this day, this family tradition remains.

J.P. was a quiet, easy going and wise man. He took these characteristics after his father Willie. One of his favorite sayings: "One day at a time."

During his final stay at the hospital, he was given a dark diagnosis. Buck replied

"Give me my pants and my shoes. I'm going home!" His parting words to his family were, "I'm gonna be alright!"
