Deacon Jerry Evans, 73, of Peoria, IL passed away at 12:32 pm on Saturday, April 23, 2022 at UnityPoint Health Methodist.

He was a faithful member of Pillar of Truth C.O.G.I.C., where he served as a

trusted and well-respected Deacon until his health failed.
