Deacon Johnnie Hardimon, Jr., 87, of Peoria, IL transitioned to his heavenly home at 4:58 pm on Tuesday, December 20, 2022 at his home.

Johnnie was born on April 14, 1935 in Prescott, Arkansas to proud parents Johnnie and Annie Mae (Reed) Hardimon, Sr. Johnnie married the love of his life, Jewel Burton on July 3, 1954 and to their union six children were born.

Johnnie had a great work ethic that enabled him to provide a wonderful life for his family. He worked at Komatsu on the assembly line Building CAB Deck for many years, retiring in 2003. He also worked with Peoria Maverick for over 15 years. He was a member of the International Brotherhood of Boilermakers and the Iron Ship Builders and Blacksmiths since 1973.

Johnnie was a Deacon at his church for many years. "Walk with me Lord, walk with me", was his favorite song. He loved singing it and the church loved listening to him when he sang. He loved math and there was no way you were going to add any numbers before he gave you the answer. He enjoyed fishing, playing games, word search, watching old cowboy pictures football and basketball games. He loved playing baseball which his mother's brother taught him. He played first base. His uncle also taught him how to hunt and fire a gun. He loved to hear his son Johnnie quote Eph 6:10-17. Back in the day he could go to the movies if you had a girl with you for 20 cents and that

included popcorn. He would walk 2 miles to the movie at least 2 times a week. He loved to travel with his wife Jewel and spent time with his family.

Johnnie leaves to cherish his most precious memories, four sons, Johnnie (Dianna) Hardimon, III, Sammie Hardimon; Minister Ezell (Rosetta) Hardimon all of Peoria, IL and Alvin (Yolanda) Hardimon of Los Vegas, NV; three daughters, Dorothy (Walter) Haley, Minister Deborah (Rev.
