Kay Frances Welch, age 68, of Peoria, IL passed away on Wednesday, October 27, 2021 at her home.

Kay was born October 27, 1953 in Peoria, to Leonard Lee and Eva Shortridge.

Kay is survived by son, Arthur (Jodi) Welch III of Bloomington, IL; one grandson, AJ Welch IV of Bloomington; one granddaughter, Nicole Richmond of Springfield, IL; one great granddaughter; four brothers, Terry Shortridge, Kenny (Tracey) Shortridge, Greg (Mauri) Johnson, and Glen Shortridge; special family friend, Fan Crooks; many cousins, nieces, nephews and family and friends.
