Mr. Kyle Stewart Kunkel, 54, of Humble, Texas, and formerly of Kempton, Pennsylvania, passed away at 3:46 pm on Monday, January 27, 2025, in Canton, Illinois.

Kyle was born in Reading, Pennsylvania on December 13, 1970, to Warren and Edythe (Edinger) Kunkel.

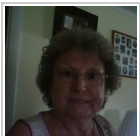

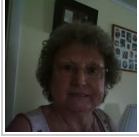
