

Mr. Larry "Snake" Howard Sr.

Mr. Larry "Snake" Howard, Sr. 70, of Peoria, IL passed away at 1:22 PM on Friday, September 12, 2014 at OSF St. Francis Medical Center.

Larry was born on June 13, 1944 in Chicago to Otis and Annie (Williams) Howard, Sr. Larry graduated from Crane High School in Chicago. He matriculated at Lincoln University in Jefferson City, MO where he graduated and later was inducted into their Basketball Hall of Fame. It was Larry's love for basketball that brought him to the Peoria Community where he was a member of the Peoria Chiefs of the CBA and later was a well respected Referee with the IHSA. Larry was heavily involved at the George Washington Carver Center where he touched many lives. He worked there and showcased his basketball savvy. Larry was a CNA at Sharon HealthCare for nearly 30 years where he also directed patient activities. He was an Executive Board member with the UFCW Union where he was a Steward.

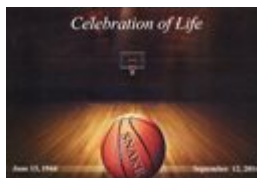
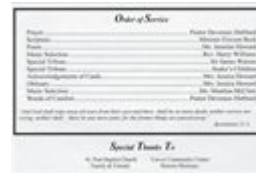
