Mr. Lee "Ed" Edward Jackson, 64 of Houston, Texas (formerly of Peoria, Illinois) passed away May 10, 2017 at Memorial Hermann Hospital in Houston, TX.

Ed, as he was affectionately known, was born on October 28, 1952 in Cruger, Mississippi to Jimmie and Legertha (Ross) Jackson.

He accepted Christ as his savior as a teenager at St. Paul Baptist Church in Peoria, IL.

Ed is survived by his wife, Hiawatha (Johnson) Jackson, three sons Andre Moszee of Urbana, IL, Omar Johnson, Isaac Jackson and one daughter, Octavia Johnson all of Houston, six grandchildren, two brothers Ray Jackson, Craig Jackson of Peoria, four sisters Denise Jackson of Peoria, Janice Hightower and Sherry Beatty both of Houston, Cheryl Jackson of Los Angeles, CA, a host of nieces, nephews and relatives. Ed is preceded in death by his parents and one brother, Leon Jackson.

Ed was a very active member at Houston Praise and Worship Center Church where he served as Deacon, Trustee and Sunday school teacher. He loved his church and interacting with people and loved visits to Peoria where he would meet with old friends.
