Lott Pickett, Jr. .73, of Peoria Heights, IL, passed away at his home on Sunday, July 15, 2012 at 1:05 am. Lott was born January 18, 1939, in Wyatt, Missouri, to Lott Pickett, Sr. and Dorothy (Davis) Pickett. He was joined in holy matrimony to Mary Ella Jackson on December 5, 1964, in Peoria.

Surviving are his wife of 47 years, Mary Pickett and children Blair Pickett, Lott (Keisha) Pickett, and Jolonda Pickett, Kertrina (Elmer) Dickerson, Brenda (George) Yetton, and Linda Myricks; one granddaughter, Brittney Pickett, whom he reared; three brothers, Floyd (Elois) Pickett, Moses (Mabel) Pickett, and Henry Pickett; and fifteen grandchildren and six great grandchildren.

Lott is preceded in death by his parents, two brothers, and five sisters.

A longtime member of the Pentecostal Church of Jesus Christ, Lott retired from Caterpillar in 1991 after thirty years of service. He also owned a lawn care business—I Can Do A Lott.
