



Mr. Malvin G. Hightower

September 16, 1949 - March 7, 2015

Mr. Malvin G. Hightower, 65, of Peoria, IL passed away peacefully surrounded by his family at 3:25 AM , Saturday, March 7, 2015 at his home.

Malvin was born on September 16, 1949 in Peoria to Marilyn (Jones) and the late Rev. Calvin Hightower. He was a 1968 graduate of Manual High School. He married Preshell Hawkins in 1969. Malvin was a decorated US Army Veteran serving during the Vietnam Conflict. He worked as an International Relations Coordinator with Caterpillar, retiring in 2009 after over 40 years of service.

Malvin is survived by his daughters, Shonda (Curt) Hightower-Hinton of Sun City, Arizona and Keva (Marcus) Hightower-Oates of Savannah, GA; his companion, Mary Page of W. Peoria; three precious grandchildren, Kyle, Kara and Ryen; two brothers, Calvin (Celia) Hightower and The Rev. Marvin (Loreece) Hightower both of Peoria; two sisters, Phyllis (Ron) Bartlett of Shorewood, IL and Robin (Jerry) Jordan of Peoria; and a host of nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends. He is preceded in death by his parents, grandparents and one nephew.

Funeral services will be held at 10 AM on Saturday, March 14, 2015 at Prince of Peace Missionary Baptist Church with a visitation one hour prior beginning at 9 AM. Pastor Simon J. Holly, Jr., will officiate and the Pastor Marvin Hightower of Liberty Church of Peoria will bring the eulogy. Malvin will be laid to rest at Swan Lake Cemetery Field of Honor.

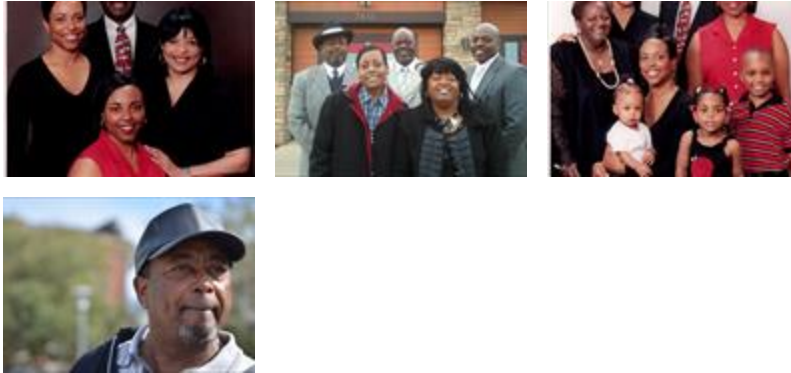
