December 19, 1941 - February 12, 2026

Mr. Marion Lampkin, III, 84, Biloxi, MS formerly of Peoria, IL, transitioned from this life to eternal rest at 5:39 pm on Thursday, February 12, 2026 at Biloxi Veterans Medical Healthcare Center, Biloxi, MS.

Marion was born on December 19, 1941, in Peoria, IL to Marion, Jr. and Ouckevious (Daniels) Lampkin.

Marion graduated from Woodruff High School where he excelled in basketball, football, and track. He later joined the Marines and after returning home from military service he worked for Caterpillar Tractor Company retiring after 30 years. He also served in the Air National Guard retiring after 23 years of service.

Marion gave his life to Christ at a young age. He was a member of Morning Star M.B. Church for over 60 years under the leaderships of the late Rev. John Henry Rodgers, the late Rev. Calvin Hightower, Sr. and the Rev. Cleveland Thomas, Sr. He served as a choir member in the male chorus, young adult choir, trustee and finance department. Marion later joined Zion Baptist Church under the leadership of Pastor Samuel Duren. He enjoyed being a Den Cub Scout Leader, refereeing high school basketball events, coaching the Jr. TNBA (The National Bowling Association) and attending Drake Relays track and field events. Marion was

an avid bowler, pool shooter, dancer, card player (especially Bid Whist). He also had a passion for cutting grass for people in the neighborhood. He also, was a faithful donor of giving blood to the Red Cross for over 20 years.
