EAST PEORIA - Mrs. Marylouise (Marshall) Gilkesson of East Peoria, IL, passed away at 1:31 p.m. on Thursday, June 2, 2011, at OSF Saint Francis Medical Center in Peoria, IL.

She was born in Vicksburg, MS, to Robert and Maggie (Morris) Marshall. She graduated from Prairie View A&M University in Prairie View, TX. Marylouise married Alfred C.

Gilkesson, and to that union four children were born. Alfred Sr. and Marylouise shared more than 53 years of holy matrimony. He preceded her in death in January 1998.

Marylouise leaves to cherish her precious memories her loving and devoted family: her daughter, Florence L. Gilkesson of East Peoria; her sons, Robert M. A funeral Mass will be held Tuesday, June 7, 2011, at 11 a.m. at St. Joseph's Catholic Church, with a visitation one hour prior, beginning at 10 a.m., and a two-hour visitation will be on Monday, June 6, 2011, from 5 to 7 p.m. at Simons Mortuary in Peoria. The Rev. James Kruse will officiate the Mass. Marylouise will be laid to rest in Fondulac Township Cemetery in East Peoria, Ill.
