In the early afternoon of Monday, February 3, 2025, at 12:54 p.m., Mary Joyce peacefully closed her eyes on Earth, surrounded by her family at OSF St. Francis Hospital, and opened them in Heaven.

Affectionately known as "Mae Joyce", she was the last living matriarch of her family—a pillar of strength, wisdom, and boundless love. 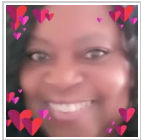
