Mother Nana B. Banks, 92, of Peoria, IL transitioned from this life to her heavenly home at 7:29 pm on Wednesday, February 4, 2021 at her home surrounded by her loving and devoted family.

Nana was born on May 18, 1928 in Lexington, Mississippi to loving parents, John, Sr., and Lubirtha (Marshall) Sargent. She married the love of her life, James Buchanan Banks, Sr., on August 5, 1949 in Lexington, MS. Shortly after their marriage, James moved his family to Peoria, IL. James and Nana were married 58 years until his passing on September 21, 2007. Nana was the matriarch of her family. She loved the Lord. Nana and James raised their children in the church at New Morning Star M.B. Church where she faithfully served for many years as a member of the Choir, Calendar Tea, Mothers and Deaconess boards. Mother Nana had a great sense of humor. She loved cooking, raising her kids and loving up on her grandchildren.
