Mrs. Naomi Shird-Tucker, 83, transitioned to her heavenly home at 7:30 am on Sunday, July 16, 2023 at OSF Richard L. Owens Hospice Home.

Mother Naomi affectionally known as “Nay” was born on May 15, 1940 in Pulaski, IL to Frank and Mary (Lilly) Shird. She was married to her beloved, Bobbie “Sonny” Tucker, in Peoria, IL on June 5, 1999.

Mother Naomi retired from Methodist Medical Center as a Licensed Practical Nurse after 30 years of service. She worked at Big John’s BBQ as a cook and waitress.
