



Missionary Omie Lee Taylor

September 29, 1941 - February 26, 2026

Missionary Omie Lee Taylor, 84, of Peoria, IL, passed away at 5:45 a.m. on Thursday, February 26, 2026.

Omie was born on September 29, 1941 in Bourbon, MS to Elder Omie and Mother Bessie (Landon) Taylor.

Omie worked for Illinois Central College, East Peoria, IL in the (AIT) Agricultural and Industrial Technology Building as an Administrative Assistant. She started working there in 1973 and retired after working 34 years of service in 2007.

In 1950 Omie became a member at Lincoln Street COGIC under the leadership of Superintendent William Clark. She served in the Sunshine Band, the Purity Class and the youth choir. In 1980 Omie transferred to Christ Temple COGIC under the leadership of her father, Elder Omie Taylor. In 2000 she joined Holy Temple COGIC under the leadership of Elder Eddie Davis where she served as a Sunday School Teacher, Sunday School Superintendent, Prayer and Bible Band Teacher, choir member and treasurer. She was also a member of the Greater Central District where she was secretary to Missionary Pam Flagg and later promoted to District Field Representative. After being called to the missionary field, she became a licensed missionary with the Church of God in Christ, Southern Illinois Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction, Greater Central District. Her motto was "Called by

God & not by man."

Omie loved to travel, especially cruises, attend family and church gatherings, and crossword puzzles.

Omie leaves to cherish her most precious memory, one sister, Romona Williams of Jackson, MS; and a host of other relatives and friends who loved her dearly. Omie was preceded in death by her parents; one son, Anthony "Tony" Taylor; six brothers, James Taylor, Robert (Barbara) Taylor, Greg Taylor, including three infant brothers; one infant sister and one brother-in-law, Bob Williams.

Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. on Saturday, March 14, 2026, at Faith Tabernacle COGIC, with visitation one hour prior at 9 a.m. Pastor Felton Beck, Jr. will officiate. Omie will be laid to rest at Parkview Cemetery.
