Centenarian Mrs. Pearly Mae Bonds

Our beloved Mrs. Pearly Mae Bonds, 100, of Peoria, IL, transitioned to her heavenly home at 8:50 pm on Saturday, June 29, 2024, at The Loft Rehabilitation and Nursing Home.

Pearly was born on October 4, 1923, in Curve, TN to Oscar and Elizabeth (Mitchell) Stinson, Sr. She married TR Bonds on October 31, 1942, in Caruthersville, MO. He preceded her in death 29 years ago, on June 29, 1995.

Although she traveled to many cities and states, Mrs. Bonds said there is no place like Peoria, IL.

Pearly accepted Christ as her personal Lord and Savior at an early age. She sang in the church choir and served on several church committees and boards as a member of Friendship Baptist Church, Grace Baptist Church, and later, Ward Chapel A.M.E. Church in Peoria, IL. Mrs. Bonds was a faithful member and officer of the Ward Chapel AME Church for over 50+ years, she loved her church immensely. She was one of the church's influencers and was an invaluable Pastoral Advisor. Mrs. Bonds served the church in many capacities such as Pastor's Aid, Steward and choir member. She founded the

Willing Workers Club and was a member of the Wilberforce Club. Over the years, she also led the voter's registration drive at the church and in the community.

Throughout her lifetime, she has dedicated herself to the cause of civil rights. Mrs. Bonds has received many awards and accolades. She was instrumental in getting the NAACP building donated from the City of Peoria; her efforts were also publicly celebrated when the building was renamed the "Pearly M. Bonds Community Center" in 2014.

- A champion for African Americans seeking jobs throughout the 1960s, 1970s, and 1980s
- A mentor and adviser to the African American Hall of Fame leadership team and other community leaders (Andre Bohannon, Junior Watkins, Pastor Howard Johnson, Eric Turner, Rosemary McCullough, and others who serve the greater Peoria area)

Pearly leaves to cherish her loving memory, her son, James Bond of Aubrey, TX; five grandchildren, Carlos Jones, Teon Metts, and D'Mir Henderson, all of Peoria, IL; Kristopher Poynter of Louisville, KY, and Avante' Bond of Carrollton, TX; Ten-great-grandchildren; Sisters: Lillian Crooks of Glassboro, NJ and Alice Montine Brown of Chicago, IL, one brother Joseph Bedford Stinson (Marlene) of Sacramento, CA, and a host of other beloved family and friends. She is preceded in death by her parents, husband, and daughter, Theresa "Terry" Bonds; brothers, Joseph E. Graves, Eddie Stinson, and William Stinson; and sisters, Virginia Stinson Donaldson, Girtie B. Phillips, and Maggie L. Jamison.

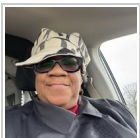
