Mr. Pete Hardy, 82, of Hazelcrest, IL; formerly of Peoria, IL passed away at 11:05 am, Tuesday, September 7, 2021 at South Suburban Rehabilitation Center in Homewood, IL.

Hardy, as he was affectionately known, was born on July 17, 1939 in Clarksdale, MS, to proud parents Sampson, Sr., and Jeannie (Brackett) Hardy.

Hardy was a proud U.S. Army Veteran, honorably serving his country from July, 23, 1959 to July 23, 1962.
