Mr. Richard Allen Foley, 51, of Peoria Heights, passed away at 12:10 pm on Tuesday, August 27, 2024 at his residence.

Richard affectionately known as Rich was born in Chicago, IL on October 27, 1972 to Ralph and Marlene (Berman) Foley. His parents preceded him in death.

Rich attended East Peoria Community High School, and graduated with Bachelor's and Master's degrees in Criminal Justice at Lewis University, Romeoville, IL.
