



## Mr. Robert Earl Marshall

August 7, 1942 - July 11, 2014

Mr. Robert Earl Marshall, 71, of Los Angeles, CA, passed away on July 12, 2014 at Veterans Administration Hospital in Westwood, CA.

Robert was born on August 7, 1942 to Robert and Rosa (Johnson) Marshall in Memphis, TN. He married Beryl Jones in 1968.
