Mr. Sidney Carey, Jr., 72, entered into eternal rest, on Wednesday, May 28, 2025 at his home in Antelope CA, surrounded by his loving family.

Sidney was an altar boy at Saint Patrick School and wanted to be a priest. He attended Blaine Sumner Elementary, Spalding and then went on to Manual High School.
