Elder Sol Samuel Terrell, Jr., 94, of Peoria, IL transitioned peacefully to his heavenly home at 10:11 am on Monday, August 20, 2018 at Unity Point Proctor Hospital surrounded by his family.

Sol was born on September 24, 1923 in York, Alabama to Sol Sr., and Emma (Pearson) Terrell. He married the love of his life, Roxie Lee Walker, on August 15, 1950. She preceded him in death on March 29, 2009 after 59 years of marriage.

Sol was a quiet giant who worked hard and loved his family and church. For many years, he owned and operated the gas station on 5th and Sheridan street where he was a mechanic and enjoyed working on cars. He later worked as a security guard at the Allied Agency for 22 years retiring in 1990. Sol was a faithful member of Central Church of God where he and his wife, Roxie, were founding members. Sol formerly served his church as Elder, deacon, head usher and maintenance engineer. Sol enjoyed fishing, hunting and family gatherings. He was also a sharp dresser.
