Ms. Theresa Annette Bonds, 68, Beltsville, MD, formerly of Peoria, IL, passed away at 2:20 pm on Wednesday, May 22, 2024 at Montgomery Hospice Casey House, Rockville, MD.

Theresa was born on September 5, 1955 in Peoria, IL to T.R. and Pearly (Stinson) Bonds.

Theresa attended Benedictine College for Women in St. Joseph, MN. She served in the US Army with a honorable discharge in 1979. She also served in the Army Reserves. Theresa just retired from reserves around the age of 60. Her most impactful and leadership role was 1SG, which is a First Sergeant. As 1SG she earned the respect of officers, enlisted Soldiers and civilian employees. Her wealth of knowledge got a lot of us promoted." Theresa worked as a patient advocate at Walter Reed National Military Medical Center for many years.
